





Australia's first pulsed Thulium:YAG laser delivers positive first-year results

In the first year since acquiring Australia's first pulsed Thulium:YAG laser, surgeons at St John of God Murdoch Hospital have helped 233 patients with kidney stones, enlarged prostates and other urological conditions spend fewer minutes under anaesthesia, and be on the road to recovery sooner.

St John of God Murdoch Hospital was the first health care facility in Australia to adopt Thulio®, a pulsed high-power Thulium:YAG laser by Dornier MedTech.

The addition of Thulio® has bolstered St John of God Murdoch Hospital's already-comprehensive urology capabilities.

St John of God Murdoch Hospital Head of Urology, Dr Jeff Thavaseelan has welcomed the additional procedural option. He says the positives of the thulium crystal laser technique have been two-fold, "This has certainly improved our theatre efficiency and more importantly, for the patient, has reduced the procedural time under anaesthesia."

Enhancement of stone treatment capabilities

The Dornier Thulio® is a compact 100W surgical laser that provides enhanced capabilities for endo-urology treatments from stones to benign prostatic hyperplasia (BPH – non-cancerous enlargement of the prostate).

By integrating a Tm:YAG laser crystal with pulsed diodes and the proprietary RealPulse® Technology, Dornier has reimagined and revolutionised thulium crystal laser technology for peak performance and versatility.

Globally, the Dornier Thulio® is quickly gaining recognition for its capability in the treatment of stones and BPH, with installations steadily increasing since its launch in late 2022. St John of God Murdoch Hospital led the way in Australia with its inaugural installation on August 7, 2023.
